

# Devdiscourse Syndication Policy

Devdiscourse encourages the responsible sharing and dissemination of information that advances knowledge, dialogue, and action on global development issues. This Syndication Policy governs the republication, redistribution, and reuse of content published on Devdiscourse.

## 1. Ownership of Content

Unless otherwise stated, all original content published on Devdiscourse, including articles, analyses, reports, interviews, graphics, data visualizations, photographs, videos, and other editorial materials, is the intellectual property of Devdiscourse and is protected by applicable copyright laws.

## 2. Permitted Use

The following uses are permitted without prior written approval:
